## Disability Stations Materials List

- 2 pair of oversized “clown” shoes that tie with laces
- Several backpacks or outerwear clothes (hoodies or jackets)

- 4 pairs dark glasses or sunglasses
- 4 pair of sleep aid eye masks (*can be purchased at most dollar stores or pharmacies*)

- Tactile dice [*available from many educational outlets*]
- Traceable pattern (i.e. star shape)
- Transparency sheet [*available from office supply outlets*]
- Transparency marker [*available from many educational outlets*]
